**ORDER APPROVING PROPOSED PLAN FOR  
DISTRIBUTION OF SETTLEMENT FUNDS**

AND NOW, this 15th day of October, 2019, upon consideration of Direct Purchaser Plaintiff’s Proposed Plan for Distribution of Funds Received in Settlements with the MITSUBA, DENSO, Calsonic and T.RAD Defendants (the “Radiators Settlement Fund”), and following a duly noticed hearing on October 3, 2019, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Court approves the Plan for Distribution of Settlement Funds set forth in the Notice of Proposed Settlements of Direct Purchaser Class Action with the MITSUBA, DENSO, Calsonic and T.RAD Defendants and Hearing on Settlement Approval and Related Matters, and the related Claim Form, as a fair and reasonable method to calculate claims and to distribute the Radiators Settlement Fund to Settlement Class members.

2. The Radiators Settlement Fund, with accrued interest, less any amounts approved by the Court for payment of attorneys’ fees, litigation and administration costs and expenses, and an incentive award for the Class Representative will be distributed *pro rata* among the members of the Settlement Classes who submit timely and valid Claim Forms. If a Settlement Class

member excludes itself from one or more of the settlements, it shall not receive a share of any settlement from which it opted out.
