**ORDER APPROVING PROPOSED PLAN FOR  
DISTRIBUTION OF SETTLEMENT FUNDS**

AND NOW, this 24<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2022, upon consideration of Direct Purchaser Plaintiff's Proposed Plan for Distribution of Settlement Funds received in the settlements with the Aisan, DENSO, HIAMS, Keihin, Maruyasu, Mikuni, MITSUBA, and MITSUBISHI ELECTRIC Defendants (the "Fuel Injection Systems Settlement Fund"), and following a duly noticed hearing on March 10, 2022, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Court approves the Plan for Distribution of Settlement Funds set forth in the Notice of Proposed Settlements of Direct Purchaser Class Action with Aisan, Mikuni, Keihin, and Maruyasu Defendants and Hearing on Settlement Approval and Related Matters, and Claim Form as a fair and reasonable method to calculate claims and to distribute the Fuel Injection Systems Settlement Fund to Settlement Class members.

2. The Fuel Injection Systems Settlement Fund, with accrued interest, less any amounts approved by the Court for payment of attorneys' fees, litigation and administration costs and expenses, and a service award to the Class Representative, will be distributed *pro rata* among the members of the Settlement Classes who have submitted timely and valid Claim

Forms. If a Settlement Class member excludes itself from one or more of the Settlement Classes, it shall not receive a share of any settlement from which it opted out.
