**ORDER APPROVING PROPOSED PLAN FOR
DISTRIBUTION OF SETTLEMENT FUNDS**

AND NOW, this 25th day of August, 2017, upon consideration of Direct Purchaser Plaintiffs' Proposed Plan for Distribution of Funds Received in Settlements with the Chiyoda, Fujikura, G.S. Electech, Lear, LEONI, Sumitomo, Tokai Rika, and Yazaki settlements (the "Wire Harness Settlement Fund"), and following a duly noticed hearing on August 8, 2017, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Court approves the Plan of Distribution of Settlement Funds set forth in the Notice of Proposed Settlements of Direct Purchaser Class Action with Chiyoda, Fujikura, LEONI, Sumitomo, and Yazaki Defendants and Hearing on Settlement Approval and Related Matters, and Claim Form (the "Notice") as a fair and reasonable method to calculate claims and to distribute the Wire Harness Settlement Fund to Settlement Class members.

2. The Wire Harness Settlement Fund, with accrued interest, less any amounts approved by the Court for payment of attorneys' fees, litigation and administration costs and expenses, and incentive awards for the Class Representatives will be distributed *pro rata* among

the members of the Settlement Class who submit timely and valid Claim Forms. If a Settlement Class member excludes itself from one or more of the settlements, it shall not receive a share of any settlement from which it opted out.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
